Shipping	Knee to ground	hock to ground	7-8	12-16'	Every 24 hours
Standing	base of the knee to below the fetlock	base of the hock to below the fetlock	6-8	10-12'	Every 12 hours
Exercise	just below the knee to the fetlock	just below hock to fetlock	6-8	Approximately 9' (varies)	After a short time
Polo Wraps	below knee to fetlock	below hock to fetlock	X	Varies - 9' - 12'	After a short time
Shipping tail bandage	dock to end of tail bone		X	4" wide, stretchy, can be track bandage, crepe or ace bandage	Every few hours (use a tail guard for longer shipping)
Grooming tail bandage	dock to end of tail bone		X	4" wide, stretchy, can be track bandage, crepe or ace bandage	half an hour for the desired effect
Full tail bandage	dock to end of tail bone		X	4" wide, stretchy, can be track bandage, crepe or ace bandage	Short time
